Adidias Construction Update

- Alexandrea called the meeting to order at 6:35pm.
- Chris T stated that Adidas will try to send someone to the Holiday Party on December 13th
- Intersection building (west side of Greeley) is due to be complete on or about 12.2.19
- South Building (near playground) due to be completed June 2020
- North Building is due to be completed by the end of 2020, this is the building with 5 stories of underground parking.
- The light on Greeley will be re-timed when the construction is complete
- Adidas will put in a cycle track along Greeley from Going north to (?) on the west side of the road, it will connect to PDoT Bike Lane that runs on the east side of Greeley from Interstate to Going St.
- Question was asked about the 5 houses that Adidas owns next to the campus, it was stated that they are improperly using the property for meeting and construction crews. They are being fined for the improper use of these houses.
- Cranes are to come down June 2020

Parking Permit Zone around Adidas

- Adidas offered to pay for 14 months of parking in the "zone" around the campus, it will run through
 2020
- What are the boundaries? Gay street east to Greeley, Humbolt north to Killingsworth and a few streets on the west side of Greeley.
- What hours do we need enforcement? 9-5pm monday friday
- How long are visitors without a permit allowed? 1 hour

- How many permits per house? 2 parking permits and one guest permit will be provided by Adidas.
- There might be a chance to have a special pool of extra permits for houses with special circumstances
- Signs will go up in January 2020 and stay till about March 2021.

Board Reports

- Sustainability = May sent a message to the board that there is a meeting on November 20th at 2pm to ban all new fossil fuel. She is also asking for others to join the sustainability group for our neighborhood.
- Transportation = Brad
 4 of the 6 lanes coming off Swan Island are now open.
 - Ainsworth and Interstate light has a broken loop, the city was asked to take a look at the timing
- Public Safety = George stated the PSAC still has a pulse but it has not been determined when the next meeting will be scheduled.
- Events and Marketing = The board is looking at charging businesses to list their business in the Overlook Views, asking for a \$25 donation for a paper that goes out to about the neighborhood. 3650 papers are printed every 3 months.
- Treasurer = Brad..\$28,000 in the bank
- School Liaison = John P, has tried to contact Ivy School about using the space for general meeting but has yet to get a response. A community member who lived near Ivy when they were at their prior location stated that Ivy School is not great at engaging with the surrounding community. John stated he will continue to engage with Ivy School.
- Engagement = Toby has built a survey for the meeting asking basic questions about attendance. Age, Race, Reside in Overlook?, Business, homeowner, renter?, Why did you attend? How can we better engage with the neighborhood?
- Homeless Outreach = Peter P stated that everyone is welcome to attend the weekly meeting at Hazlenut Grove...Saturdays at 11am.

- Jenna asked about our Social Media as it seems to be lacking. Facebook has very little engagement. Do we want to start an Instagram account?
- Ross Bradley introduced himself as he has taken over the Failing Street Bridge cleanup. The cleanup happens on Saturdays at 10am, bring gloves if you have them.
- Stephan Williams introduced himself as a neighbor and stated he might be able to help with the social media.
- Susan Hayden thanked Chris for his work on the parking around Adidas.
- Jenna also stated that Atomic Pizza on Denver & Killingsworth is collecting items for Toys for Tots, specifically looking for PJ's, socks & toys.
