- Kent will bring back ideas for CD's and interest bearing account

## b. Parks (Cynthia Sulaski)

- ICURA (Interstate Corridor Urban Renewal Area) is trying to decide how to spend their parks money over the next 5 years. Committee is doing outreach now to gather input on parks and green space priorities and needs in the corridor. Cynthia will email info. Questions and concerns about matching parks to increasing density in the Interstate Corridor and the possible acquisition of new park land, particularly at the Jefferson High School site south of Alberta and the old Kenton school.
