### **Chair Report**

- Chris called the meeting to order at 6:33pm.
- Approval of prior meeting minutes
- Motion: Alexandra moves to approve the minutes from July 3 and July 17; Mike Shea seconds
  - o **Board Vote:** Chris asked if any objections to approving the meeting minutes. No objections.
- Adidas put up no smoking signs to direct employees to designated smoking areas and away from houses
- The City and Joint Office of Homeless Services is close to announcing when Hazelnut Grove will be relocated

### **Overlook Tote Bags**

- Tote bags \$5.66 each to print using one color = \$283 for 50
- Will sell them at the movie in the Park event for \$10
- *Motion:* Kristina moves to spend \$283 for 50 tote bags; Mike Shea seconds
  - o **Board Vote:** Chris asked if any objections. No objections.

### **Gateway to Nature Signs**

- Lester Viles North Portland Project Association is an organization in North Portland that gives small grants to organizations in NoPo: http://lvnppa.org/
- LVNPPA wants to put two more Gateway to Nature signs in NoPo one in Kenton and one on Interstate
- LVNPPA has the funding but they are requesting neighborhood support
- The 2019 funding cycle has not opened yet but check the website for updates; grant a total of \$10-15k

### **Letter about Neighborhood Notification Changes**

- Changes are being made to the notification process for new developments which would allow developers to no longer have to present their proposals at a neighborhood association meeting
- OKNA opposes that change and Chris has drafted a letter
- Motion: Mike S moves to submit the letter responding to the new proposal; Cynthia seconds
  - o **Board Vote:** Chris asked if any objections. No objections.

### **September Elections**

- Will run the election the same way as last year people will be on the ballot if they submit their name a week prior; people can also become a write-in candidate at the meeting
- Suggestion to bring in members of the St Johns NA to monitor our election and vice versa
- Everyone will stand up and give a short presentation on who they are and why they want to be on the Board; everyone in the audience will vote
- Will be an announcement in the newsletter, in the email, through signage, etc.
- Action: any Board members that want to be on the ballot submit their names to Chris via email

### **Funding for the NoPo Transportation Summit**

- There were suggestions to invite people from the Expo Center and Delta Park and the Swan Island businesses Cynthia can help with the Swan Island businesses
- Motion: Kent moves to fund \$100 to pay for refreshments for the NoPo Transpo Convo; Mike Shea seconds
  - Board Vote: Chris asked if any objections to approving the funding; Alexandra abstains, no objections.

### **Street Signs to Promote Events**

- Approved money to get 20 plastic corrugated signs but may not be a good environmental idea.
- Classic lawn signs are still the best idea as they can be reused multiple times
- Action: Mike Murphy to check on the signs used at the ice cream social
- Group Decision: Addie will order 10 plastic signs and we will look for other options
