#### What to expect

- Your homes will be accessible at all times, although there may be a few minutes of delay.
- The biggest disruption to your regular routine will be restricted street parking and limited access to some streets.
  - The chart on the back of this page describes in detail all streets that are affected and what to expect.
  - Our crew will post 'no parking' signs on all affected streets.
  - Flaggers will be present at key intersections to hold traffic as needed.
- Heavier than usual truck and passenger van traffic, as well as some disruptions to the regular flow of traffic.
- Security & Safety staff to ensure your safety and ours during the period of filming activity.
- We have a location manager onsite at all times, if you have any concerns with our filming activity, please reach out to one of our contacts below to help resolve any issues.

- Please feel free to briefly observe our activity from a distance, at least ½ block away.
- If onlookers get too close and in the way of the cameras, our friendly staff will let you know.
- We appreciate your support and will be working at a very fast pace and for long shifts while we are in your neighborhood; you are welcome to watch but please be respectful and do not disrupt our work.
- Remember that we are filming, so anything you see may or may not make it to the screen. Be mindful
